Dear Parents and Guardians,

After receipt and consideration of input from the community, Honor Roll requirements have been modified for student attainment of both “Merit” and “High” Honors.

Below, and on the school website, you will find the updated requirements:

HIGH HONOR ROLL

Students in grades 4-8 will meet the following criteria to earn High Honors:

1. The average rating from the four major content areas (English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies) will be a 3.0 or higher, and
2. The student will receive no “Needs Improvement” and no “Unsatisfactory” ratings for Specialty/Exploratory Classes.

MERIT HONOR ROLL

Students in grades 4-8 will meet the following criteria to earn Merit Honors:

1. The average rating from the four major content areas (English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies) will be a 2.65 or higher, and
2. The student will receive no “Needs Improvement” and no “Unsatisfactory” ratings for Specialty/Exploratory Classes.

Average Rating is calculated by taking the average of all the practices under each standard for each major content area (ELA, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies). Then the average of the four ratings in each content area will determine the overall average.
